For 4-5 year olds, with parent participation encouraged. For single parents, inter-faith parents, same-sex parents... *for all parents raising Jewish children.*

This NEW Pre-K program will serve as an introduction to Jewish songs, stories, traditions, and progressive Jewish values.

The Kadima Pre-Kindergarten meets Sundays, twice monthly, 10:00 a.m.-11:30 a.m. Gatherings this year are at our new location, Kadima House, in our new Pre-K room.

What you can expect from The Kadima Pre-Kindergarten Program:

We recognize that children of this age are already forming their identity based on what they see and hear. We offer alternative phrasing of many traditional songs or blessings to reflect unity of the intention and not a bias that may result from a language's grammatical restrictions. We also pay close attention to the pictures in a child's storybook to ensure that gender bias or skin color bias is not presented. Our Pre-K program essentially follows the same anti-bias, holistic, experiential, authentic approach to learning that Kadima provides for all of our learners and the Kadima Community.

Whether you are a continuing family or a family ready to join the ongoing cohort, here are some of the activities planned to help your preschooler develop their sense of their Jewish identity while also developing their kindergarten readiness skills:

- More Jewish songs to sing and learn
- More Jewish foods to make and new recipes to try
- More Jewish stories to hear and talk about
- More Jewish "vocabulary" to learn
- More Hebrew letters and words to learn and practice
- More Jewish arts and crafts to make, and gardens to plant
- More Jewish concepts to talk about and think about
